**SUMMARY:** The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) has announced it is accepting applications for fiscal year PPHF - 2012 Primary and Behavioral Health Care Integration Grants. The purpose of this program is to establish projects for the provision of coordinated and integrated services through the co-location of primary and specialty care medical services in community-based mental and behavioral health settings.

Approximately \$35,775,795 is available to fund up to 32 grants at \$400,000 each for 4-years. These grants are to improve the physical health status of adults with serious mental illnesses (SMI) who have or are at risk for co-occurring primary care conditions and chronic diseases, with the objective of supporting the triple aim of improving the health of those with SMI; enhancing the consumer's experience of care (including quality, access, and reliability); and reducing/controlling the per capita cost of care.

**WHO CAN APPLY:** The statutory authority for this program limits eligibility to qualified community mental health programs, as defined under section 1913(b)(1) of the Public Health Services Act, as amended.
